All Creation Waits Craft Instruction

Kids of all ages will love making this peanut butter bird feeder that will attract birds of all kinds to your backyard!

ACTIVE TIME

20 minutes

MATERIALS

Pinecone

Peanut butter

Bird seed

String, twine or wire

<u>TOOLS</u>

paper plate or pie plate

scissors

INSTRUCTIONS

Tie the string, twine or wire to the pinecone before you begin. Leave a long enough piece at the top so you can hang the pinecone bird feeder later.

Cover the pinecone in peanut butter. A thicker peanut butter works better here so it will adhere to the pinecone better.

Now, coat the peanut butter pinecone in bird seed. You can roll your pinecone in a dish, paper plate, or small bowl filled with bird seed. Then pat the bird seed in to ensure it will all stick well.

Finally, find a place to hang your Pinecone Bird Feeder outside. And enjoy watching the birds feast!
