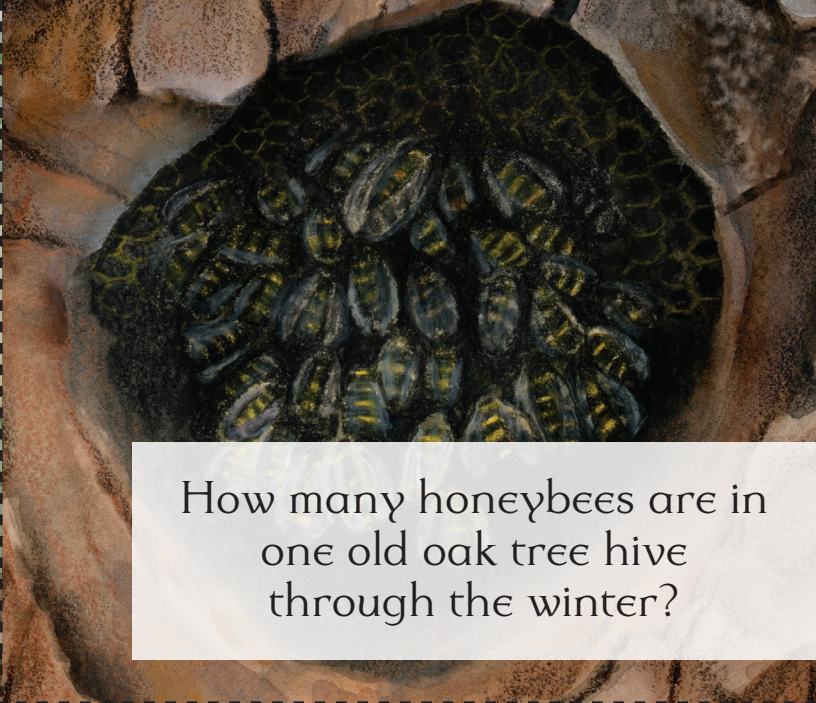


How many months will the painted turtle stop breathing in the winter?

How do parent loons change once their chicks are born?



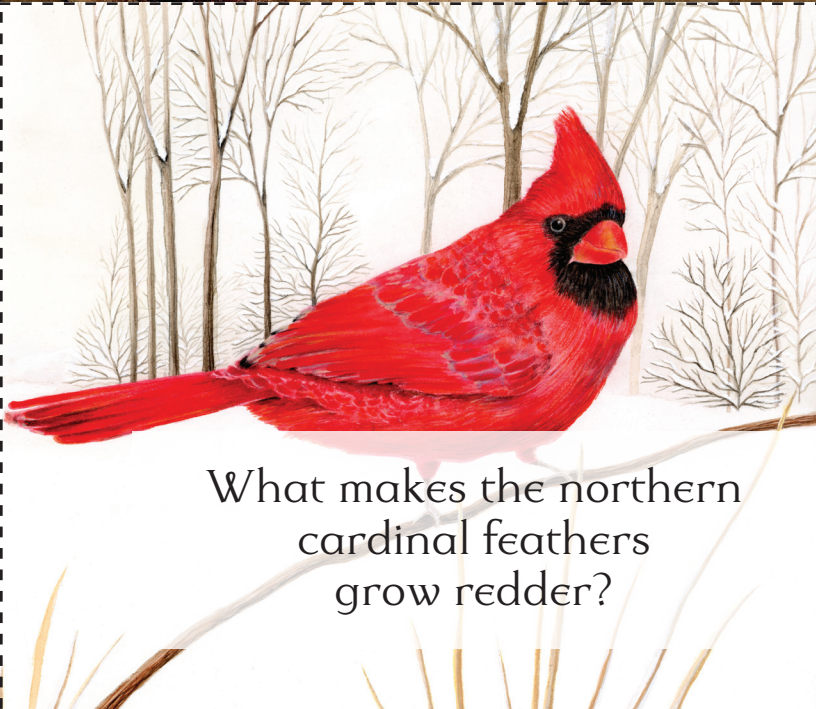
Why does the woodchuck wake up every few days in winter?
